Title: COMPETITION FOR GRANTING ONE RESEARCH SCHOLARSHIPS

A tender is open for the attribution of one Research Scholarship within the scope of the R&D Unit "Research Center for Biosciences & Health Technologies" (CBIOS), Universidade Lusófona, financed by "Fundação para a Ciência e a Tecnologia, I.P."/MCTES (FCT, I.P.), ref. UIDP/04567/2020 and UIDB/04567/2020, through national funds (PIDDAC) (OE).

Scientific Areas:

Human Biology and Biomedical Sciences

Recipients' profile/category: Bachelor degree holder in the following scientific area: Biological Sciences or related areas

Mandatory requirements:

Candidates holding a Bachelor degree in Biological Sciences or related areas of interest to the project may apply to this competition. Experience in cell biology research (3D/organoid cultures of human cells) and in nanotechnology applied to human health, can be considered an added value.

Workplace:

The work is to be carried out at the facilities of the Research Center for Biosciences & Health Technologies" (CBIOS), Universidade Lusófona, under the scientific guidance of Professor Regina Menezes who may then delegate the supervision to another researcher of CBIOS, being the entity contracting COFAC—Cooperativa de Formação e Animação Cultural CRL.

Fellowship duration:

The fellowship is for a period of 3 months, scheduled to start on 2 November 2022. The scholarship contract may eventually be renewed.

Monthly maintenance allowance amount:

The scholarship amount corresponds to € 1 100.00 based on the table of scholarships awarded directly by FCT, I.P., in the country, with payment made monthly by bank transfer.





Selection criteria:

The selection criteria shall be as follows:

- a) Experience and training drawn from the analysis of the Curriculum Vitae (50%)
- b) Bachelor course grade (20%)
- c) Scientific production in the specific area (30%)

Each of the items (a) to (c) is rated with a score from 0 to 20.

The evaluation results proposed by the juri will be notified, up to 10 days after the deadline for the submission of applications, by email, of the results proposed by the jury, with access to the minutes and the provisional ranking list.

After notification, candidates will have 10 working days to comment on the draft decision (prior hearing of interested parties, under the terms of the Code of Administrative Procedure).

A tender is open from 7 to 20 of October 2022.
